

PLANTS THAT ATTRACT HUMMINGBIRDS



Hummingbirds are a treat for any gardener.

- Attract them to your own garden by planting flowers that are long and tubular, as their beaks can fit inside quite well, while their wings are not harmed.
- As rumored, hummingbirds love the color red, so plant red flowers and hang out red feeders. These high-energy birds can burn up to 12,000 calories a day!
- A good feeding ground contains a combination of plants and feeders, as well as layering the different plant heights in your garden to appeal to the hummingbirds.

- Bird baths and fountains also work well in a hummingbird garden.
- Remember to leave some room in your garden for yourself as these birds are a pleasure to watch.
